

THE CHARTER



Adopted on 10 March 2016 - amended on 28 November 2019

The packaging-free sector addresses the issue of household waste, in particular by **avoiding food wastage and superfluous disposable packaging.**

The object of the present Charter is to **federate** those concerned by packaging-free retail, defining **commitments** to encourage the **widespread development of this mode of consumption, safeguarding both the interests of consumers and the environment.**

The Charter is subject to alterations, notably to reflect changes in the packaging-free sector.

In signing the Charter, members undertake to expressly and unreservedly promote and uphold the principles described below.

Failure to comply with obligations under this charter will give rise to a warning. Should this warning go unheeded, the committee will decide on the appropriate course of action, including exclusion.

I hereby agree to:

- 1) **Make packaging-free goods part of my business model**, and to opt for solutions that reduce waste of resources.
- 2) **Encourage packaging-free consumption** while safeguarding the health and safety of consumers, by complying with the regulations, guidelines and advice on good practices issued by public authorities and promoted by the association.
- 3) **Get involved in the association in a respectful and benevolent manner**
 - a. Take an active part in the association's activities, and
 - b. where possible, share my experience and my knowledge for the benefit of the sector as a whole.
